POST-SECONDARY INSTITUTIONS IN NOVA SCOTIA OFFER NSISP GRADUATES

1. Guaranteed university admission with an average of 70% on required courses.*
2. Guaranteed waiver of the English proficiency exam for university applicants with 70% or higher in Nova Scotia grade 12 academic English (or equivalent).
3. Guaranteed scholarship to students with an average of 85% or higher.*

ADDITIONAL FINANCIAL AWARDS

NSISP graduates are eligible to receive the following:

DOMESTIC TUITION RATES

Cape Breton University (CBU)

Domestic tuition rates (max 5 per year) at Cape Breton University for the duration of their four-year degree.

Nova Scotia Community College (NSCC)

Domestic tuition rates at NSCC in the academic year directly following graduation from a Nova Scotia high school.

Saint Mary's University (SMU)

Domestic out-of-province tuition rates at Saint Mary's for the duration of their four-year degree.

University of King's College (UKC)

Domestic out-of-province tuition rates at the University of King's College for the duration of their four-year degree.

Université Sainte-Anne

Domestic tuition fees for the duration of their diploma/certificate program.

ADDITIONAL FINANCIAL AWARDS

Acadia University

\$5000 tuition reduction in each year of their program at Acadia for up to four years for a maximum total value of \$20,000.

Mount Allison University (Mt. A)

Domestic tuition fees for the first two years of their degree program – an estimated overall savings of \$19,790.

St. Francis Xavier University (StFX)

\$5000 scholarship renewable each year of their undergraduate program at StFX for a maximum total value of \$20,000.

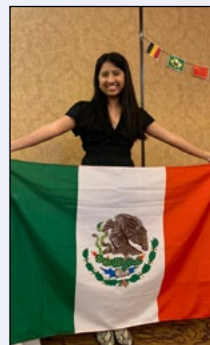
St. Thomas University (STU)

\$5000 NSISP tuition discount in each year of their undergraduate program. An estimated total value of over \$20,000.
